The Narrator	So the fisherman returned home and found his wife standing in front of a new house.
The Fisherman's Wife	Look! We have a new house now.
The Fisherman	It is really pretty.
The Fisherman's Wife	But not pretty enough. I think we need a castle.

Scene 5 (Setting: At the sea shore)

The Narrator	So the fisherman returned to the ocean and told the big fish what his wife wanted.
The Big Fish	Hmm...ok then.

Scene 6 (Setting: Outside the fisherman's house)

The Narrator	The fisherman went home and saw a big castle.
The Fisherman	This is really amazing!
The Fisherman's Wife	Yeah, it is! But you know what? Who should live in such a castle? A queen!
The Fisherman	But, don't you think we have asked for too much?
The Fisherman's Wife	I don't care. Just go and ask!

Scene 7 (Setting: At the sea shore)

The Big Fish	You want too much. Go home and see what you have gotten now!

Scene 8 (Setting: Outside the fisherman's house)

The Fisherman	I am happy if you are happy.
